

"A Peek Into Heaven"

Slide 1

The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His servants. (1:1)

Slide 2

He sent and communicated it by His angel to His servant John, who bore witness to the word of God and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, to all that he saw. (1:1,2)

Slide 3

Blessed is he who reads out loud and those who hear the words of the prophecy, and keep the things which are written in it. (1:3)

Slide 4

John to the seven churches that are in Asia. (1:4)

Slide 5

From Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne, and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the first-born of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. (1:4,5)

Slide 6

I, John, your brother and fellow-partaker in the tribulation and kingdom and perseverance, which are in Jesus, was on the island called Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus. (1:9)

Slide 7

Write in a book what you see and send it to the seven churches. (1:11)

Slide 8

After these things I looked and behold, there was a door standing open in heaven. (4:1)

Slide 9

Behold, a throne was standing in heaven, and One sitting on the throne. (4:2)

Slide 10

Seven Spirits of God, 24 elders and 4 living creatures

Slide 11

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God, the Almighty, who was and who is and who is to come." (4:8)

Slide 12

The 24 elders will fall down before Him who sits on the throne and will worship Him who lives forever and ever. (4:10)

Slide 13

Worthy are You, our God, to receive glory and honor and power: for You created all things, and because of Your will they exist and were created (4:11)

Slide 14

And I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a book. (5:1)

Slide 15

"Who is worthy to open the book?" (5:2)

Slide 16

And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the book. (5:3)

Slide 17

And I began to weep greatly because no one was found worthy to open the book. (5:4)

Slide 18

"Stop weeping! Behold, the Lion that is from the tribe of Judah, the Root of David has overcome so as to open the book and its seven seals. (5:5)

Slide 19

And I saw between the throne...and the elders a Lamb standing, as if slain. (5:6)

Slide 20

And He came, and He took the book out of the right hand of Him who sat on the throne. (5:7)

Slide 21

And they sang a new song:

"Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals, for You were slain and purchased for God with Your blood people from every tribe and tongue and people and nation." (5:9)

Slide 22

"Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing. (5:12)

Slide 23

And every created thing which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all things in them:

*"To Him who sits on the throne,
and to the Lamb
be blessing and honor and glory
and dominion forever and ever." (5:13)
