Intro

Paul has just revealed to us the purpose of his letter to the church in Rome. The theme for his letter was the saving power of the gospel and that God's righteousness was available to all who believe.

But then? Surprise! "The wrath of God is being revealed..."

*Wrath* - \_\_\_\_\_ of the soul, justifiable abhorrence
